### **RM2.7m losses in phone scams**

**KUANTAN** — A total of RM2.7 million in losses were reported in phone scams, better known as the Macau Scam, in Pahang last year, compared to RM360,000 a year earlier, a whopping 650 per cent rise.

Pahang police chief Datuk Seri Rosli Ab Rahman said even though such cases were reported in the media time and again, the number of cases continued to rise in almost all districts in the state.

He said Kuantan recorded the highest losses with RM1.152 million, followed by Rompin (RM410,100), Cameron Highlands (RM270,092), Temerloh (RM267,960), Bentong (RM210,969), Raub (RM179,596), Pekan (RM93,425), Jerantut (RM71,952), Maran (RM43,750) and Bera (RM25,217). — Bernama
